**RE: LIVINGSTON COUNTY WATER & SEWER AUTHORITY  
LEICESTER/YORK REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY EXPANSION**

Dear Mr. Falk:

The Livingston County Water & Sewer Authority (LCWSA) is proposing improvements to the various water systems in the County in order to supply water to areas of the Towns of Leicester and York affected by the Retsof Salt Mine collapse, Letchworth State Park, Livingston County Nursing Home/County Campus, as well as to address growing demands in the County. The project includes:

- Upgrades to the LCWSA Hemlock Pump Station.
- Installation of new water transmission mains in the Town of Livonia along Bronson Hill, Poplar Hill, Livonia Center, and West Lake Roads.
- Installation of a new water transmission main running along South Lima Road in the Towns of Lima, Livonia, and Avon.
- Installation of new water transmission mains running along Park Road, River Road, and Rt 39/20A in the Town of Leicester.
- Installation of a new water transmission main running along Rt 39/20A in the Town of Geneseo.
- Replacement of water mains running along East Avenue and Summer Street in the Village of Livonia.
- Replacement or the rehabilitation of the 10-inch transmission main running along Big Tree Road in the Town of Livonia.
- Installation of a new water transmission main in the Town of Leicester and Village of Mt. Morris at the Genesee River on the north end of the Village.
- Installation of a new water booster pump station in the Town of York.
- Installation of a new water storage tank in the Town of Leicester.
- Installation of a TTHM removal system in the Village of Geneseo water storage tank.
- Miscellaneous upgrades to the Village of Geneseo water treatment plant including a new generator, piping improvements, and pump upgrades.
- Upgrades to the connection with the Village of Mt. Morris along Rt 408.
- Installation of new distribution mains in the Town of York along Craig, River, and York Roads.

Under the applicable standards of Title 6 NYCRR Section 617.6(d), the LCWSA concludes that it should be designated as the Lead Agency for the coordinated environmental review of the Proposed Action. Notification is being sent to all involved / interested

agencies, with involved agencies being asked to consent to the LCWSA serving as Lead Agency for this Proposed Action.

You are receiving this notification of their lead agency intent because you have been deemed an Interested or Involved Agency. You will continue to be notified of SEQRA determinations and copies of all environmental documents will be made available to you.

In accordance with 6 NYCRR 617, all involved agencies must agree upon lead agency designation within thirty (30) days. To facilitate such agreement and to provide sufficient time for discussions, the LCWSA requests that all responses to this notice be submitted in writing and received no later than May 3, 2024. In the event that a response is not received on or before that date, your agency will be deemed to have no objection to the LCWSA assuming lead agency status for the purposes of this project.

For your information, we are enclosing Part 1 of the Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) which has been prepared for this project. The EAF documentation will be utilized to make a determination of environmental significance for the Proposed Action.

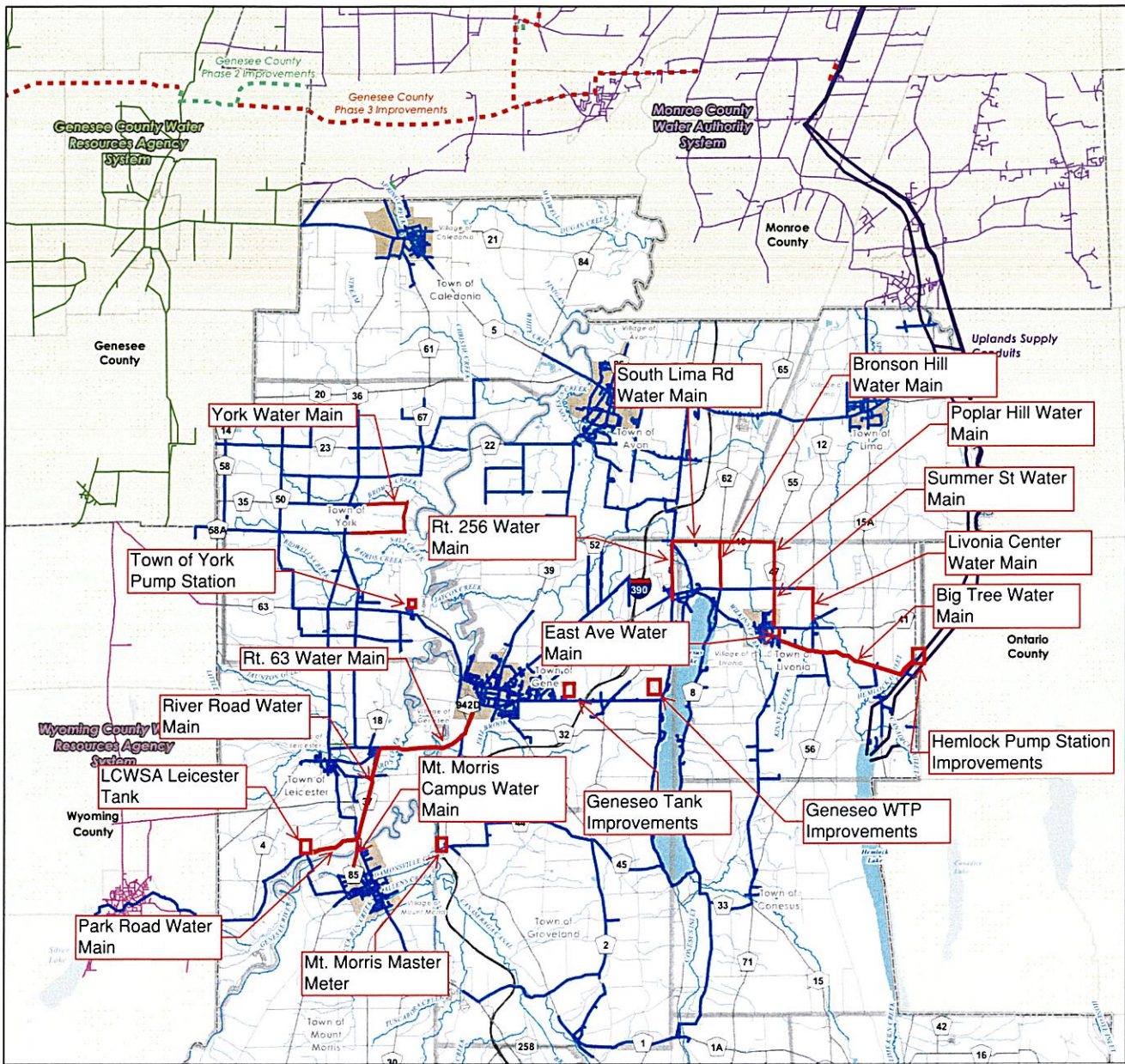

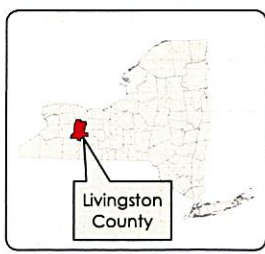
